BACKGROUND:

☐ Survey of ~800 US Consumers balanced to census to ask about virtual doctor's appointments.

FINDINGS:

- Covid caused a surge in telehealth usage, especially among older respondents (55+). A considerable percentage of the virtual gains during covid figure to hold post-covid.
- ☐ The vast majority of those who have done virtual appointments say they did so for the first time in the past six months (90% of respondents who have done virtual appointments).
- Just over half of respondents say they have been delaying doctor's visits because of the pandemic.
- Consumer sentiment toward virtual doctor's visits is very positive overall. Respondents who have done virtual appointments view the cost as the same, virtual as better for convenience, and in-person as better for quality of care / outcome of visit.
- ☐ Most respondents say they would be more likely to ask a doctor which app/platform they can use to have a virtual visit with them (~80%) as opposed to finding a tele-health platform they like and finding a doctor up there for their issue.








What percentage of your doctor's visits have been / will be virtual during the following time periods?




Response Distributions








% Change Across Time Periods











When is the last time you had a visit with a doctor?






Have you been delaying any types of doctor's visits because of the pandemic?








Have you ever done a virtual doctor appointment?








How do you compare the quality of care/outcome of virtual visits vs. in-person doctor's visits?





When you think of virtual doctor visits, which app/platform comes to mind first? (Fill-In)












In which region of the United States do you live?






Which of the following best describes your current relationship status?
