



Twitter decided this evening to permanently ban President Donald Trump from the Twitter platform. What is your opinion of Twitter's decision?






Now that President Trump is removed from Twitter, do you think Twitter will be more or less...






Will the ban of President Donald Trump from Twitter impact how much you use Twitter going forward?




For how long do you expect to use Twitter less often?





Why is your opinion of social media platforms censoring content negative?

Posed to all respondents (Gen Pop Survey Focused on Social Media Users).

"A matter of freedom of speech. If they ban someone, it's because they disagree with them."

"Because it is not their function to police the world."

"Because the censorship seems biased and some things that could be objectionable are not censored while others are."

"Because they block it not block things according to their believes."

"Censorship is hard to maintain a neutral point of view on. People don't always agree on what should be censored."

"Freedom of speech."

"Freedom of speech is the cornerstone of our country. They have no right to block ideas that are contrary to theirs."

"It is a troubling trend to censor speech. Who gets to decide?"

"Don't believe in censorship except when inciting activities that are untrue and dangerous to the rest of us."

"Everyone should have their opinions, but when it has a severe affect on society, like creating panic and mayhem, content needs controlled."


"His behavior proves that he is immature."

"I want to know what I am about to see. I want a WARNING. There are certain things and pictures I do not want to see."


"Seditious and harmful postings to the nation's democracy should be removed."

How much objectionable, offensive, or dangerous content do you think is on each of the following platforms?










During the past 12 months, how often do you think you...










Has your opinion of the following platforms improved or worsened over the past few months?




How high is your level of trust in the judgement of the following platforms to moderate the content on their platform that you interact with while using it?




What is your age?




Respondents Who Have a Negative Opinion of The Trump Twitter Ban | % Who Are Twitter Users:
