

DASH vs. CART Consumer Preferences






Which do you prefer for ordering grocery and convenience items?

Posed to all respondents who have used BOTH Instacart AND DoorDash in the past year, cross-tabbed by income.






Used DoorDash in the Past Year (For Grocery or Convenience) | Has Also Used in the Past Year...




Used Instacart in the Past Year (For Grocery or Convenience) | Has Also Used in the Past Year...



Used Uber Eats in the Past Year (For Grocery or Convenience) | Has Also Used in the Past Year...










